

Town of Danube Seeks Cemetery Grounds person 2010 Maintenance

Town of Danube will accept applications for a cemetery groundsperson for the 2010 maintenance of six (6) town cemeteries. The names and locations of the cemeteries are as follows:

- Garlock Cemetery – Johnnycake Road
- Houpt Cemetery – Fords Bush Road
- Ostrander Cemetery – W. Fiery Hill Road
- Bellinger Cemetery – Bellinger Road
- Gardinier Cemetery – Paradise Road
- Hess Cemetery – Fall Hill, Rt 5s

SCOPE OF WORK TO INCLUDE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

- Complete grass mowing
- Complete weed eating around each stone
- Removal of any small fallen tree branches
- Weeds controlled in an area no less than two (2) feet from the outside perimeter of each fence
- Removal of all old flowers, flower support fixtures and/or all other trash as needed.

TIME FRAME FOR COMPLETION OF WORK:

Work will be completed during the mowing season to keep the cemeteries looking nice, including: two (2) times before Memorial Day, one of those times not more than five (5) days before Memorial Day. One time not more than five (5) days before July 4th. One time not more than five (5) days before Labor Day. Other times as needed or in preparation for a funeral.

All necessary tools and insurance will be provided by the Town of Danube.

A vehicle will be needed to haul the trailer with the mowing equipment. Equipment will be picked up and stored at the Towns garage after each mowing. The hourly rate and mileage will begin and end at that point. Rate of pay will be \$8.00 per hour along with mileage of \$0.50 per mile.
