

## RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE TOWN OF DANUBE CEMETERIES

Adopted July 10, 2001

1. All lots in the Town of Danube Cemeteries are sold in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of New York and shall not be used for any other purposes except as a burial place for dead human beings.
2. No interment shall be allowed without permission being first obtained the Cemetery Board. At the time of applying for permission, the following information must be furnished:
  - a. Name of deceased
  - b. Age of deceased including date of birth
  - c. Place of birth of deceased
  - d. Date of death
  - e. Time and date of interment
  - f. If not an adult, the names of parent (s) or legal guardian (s) of deceased.
3. Lot owners are prohibited from allowing interments to be made on their lots for compensation
4. Interments on a lot are restricted to those entitled to be buried therein according to the terms of section 1512 of the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law. Permission for burial of those not entitled to burial according to the said section, must be filed with the Cemetery Board by the lot owner (s).
5. Except as provided for in section 1513 (c) of the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law, no lot owner may transfer his or her lot.
6. The full purchase price must be paid before a deed will be given or burial allowed on the grave. The charge to Town Residents and natives of the Township will be \$200. Non residents will be charged \$600 for each grave.
7. The Cemetery Board reserves the right to remove all flowers, wreaths, or other decorations from lots as soon as they become unsightly.
8. The Cemetery Board reserves the right to remove, after due notice to the lot owner, any embellishment on the lot, effigy or inscription which, in the majority of the Cemetery Board, is unsightly or dangerous.
9. The Cemetery Board reserves the right to restrict the planting of shrubs and trees and to remove any shrub or tree deemed dangerous to the public, upon due notice to the lot owner.
10. Funerals must be at the Cemetery by 3PM in order to give Funeral Directors workman sufficient time to properly close the grave and remove equipment before 5PM. Except by special permission from the Cemetery Board, all graves will be hand dug.

11. All funerals, processions and vehicles will be under the control of the Funeral Director while in the Cemetery
12. No vault or mausoleum will be built above ground without the permission of the Cemetery Board and then in only such location as they may approve.
13. No monuments or markers shall be permitted which utilize colors other than natural stone without full permission from the Cemetery Board
14. Placing of glass blocks or vases as receptacles for flowers, either artificial or grown, on graves or plots, is prohibited.
15. All foundations will be constructed under the direction of the Funeral Director and subject to review and approval of the Cemetery Board.
16. All work done for burials in the cemetery will be the responsibility of the Funeral Director and subject to review and approval of the Cemetery Board.
17. Only one monument shall be allowed on a lot and it shall be set in accordance with the general plan of the Cemetery and shall conform with said plan in size and material.
18. Monuments are restricted in size to dimensions which will not cover more than 10% of the surface area of the lot. Every monument shall be at least 4 inches in thickness.
19. The bases of all monuments shall be finished true and level so as to fit on foundations without wedging or sprawls.
20. No monument will be allowed to be delivered in the Cemetery until the foundation is installed and ready to receive the monument.
21. Heavy trucking or other vehicular traffic shall be refused entrance to the cemetery when, in the opinion of the Cemetery Board, injury to roads and driveways might result.
22. All persons shall be allowed access to the Cemetery during daylight hours, observing the rules which are in effect and the propriety due the Cemetery.
23. All monuments must be constructed of granite or bronze or approved by the Cemetery Board.
24. Interments on Sundays and Holidays will be governed and allowed only if approved by the Cemetery Board.
25. Graves will not be opened between November and April when frost and weather conditions warrant such refusal.
26. Cremated remains will not be permitted to be scattered in any part of the Cemetery.

27. Concrete vaults or concrete grave liners will be required for interments in all graves.
28. The interment of cremated remains will be permitted only in appropriate rigid receptacle such as wood, metal, plastic, or concrete.
29. Only single adult remains and or single cremated remains will be permitted in each grave.
30. These “Rules and Regulations” may be amended by the Town of Danube Cemetery Board after reviewed and accepted by the Danube Town Board.
